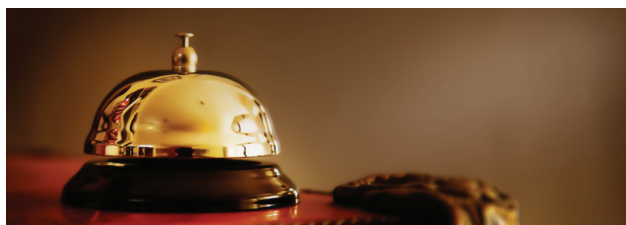

### Travel Basics

- Hundreds of islands and rocky islets make up the 30 Caribbean nations and territories
- Top five destinations:
  - St. Maarten
  - Nassau, The Bahamas
  - Exuma, The Bahamas
  - Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands
  - Anguilla
- The Caribbean climate:
  - Tropical (situated between 10° and 26° N), moderated by prevailing northeast trade winds
  - Most temperatures range between 75° F (24° C) – 90° F (32° C) for 24 hours a day
  - Rare cool temperatures below 60° F (15° C) have been experienced in northern Cuba and the northern islands of the Bahamas during winter
  - Rainy season extends from May through October
  - Dry season occurs during the North American winter months (December through February)
  - The waters of the Caribbean are warm year round
- Population: 40+ million
- Total land mass: 1.063 million square miles (2.753 million square kilometers)



### Trip Planning Musts

- Departure from U.S. Airports: Requires outbound U.S. eAPIS filing
- Arrival at Caribbean Airports: Requires inbound Caribbean Community and Common Market (CARICOM) APIS filing, depending upon where you travel to in the Caribbean
- Returning to the U.S.: Requires outbound CARICOM APIS filing, again depending on where in the Caribbean you are going and an inbound U.S. eAPIS filing as well as an U.S. CBP Notification Coordination

#### CARICOM countries requiring the CARCOM APIS filing include:

- Antigua and Barbuda
- Barbados
- Dominica
- Grenada
- Guyana
- Jamaica
- St. Kitts and Nevis
- St. Lucia
- St. Vincent and the Grenadines
- Trinidad and Tobago



### Frequently Asked Questions

#### **Q: What are the permitting requirements for Part 91 vs. Part 135?**

A: Most Part 91 flights do not require a landing permit but rather a simple flight plan on file or notification of intent to the CAA will apply. Part 135 and charter permits will be required for all locations above. Lead times vary so consult with UAS Operations in advance.

#### **Q: Is fuel readily available in the Caribbean?**

A: Fuel is mostly available, however, there may be sporadic shortages or outages during peak seasons. Always contact your service provider for verification of fuel availability.

#### **Q: What's the best way to handle Customs & Immigration?**

A: Your handler can handle this with the submission of a crew and passenger GENDEC.

#### **Q: Should I be concerned about security in the Caribbean?**

A: Typically, security is not an issue, and security at the FBOs in general is very good. Areas outside the airport, however, may require security, depending on where you are.

#### **Q: Are hotels hard to book for the crew and passengers?**

A: Hotel accommodations can be difficult to reserve during peak seasons and can also be very pricey. Plan ahead and have UAS assist you as soon as possible.

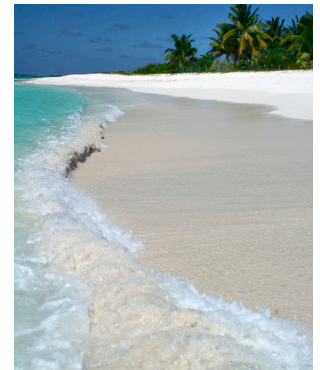

# Fun Caribbean Facts



- Approximately 2 percent of the Caribbean islands is populated.
- The dominant languages are Spanish, English, Dutch, Haitian Creole, and Papiamentu, a mixture of African and Portuguese dialects.
- The island of Saba hosts the shortest runway on Earth – a mere 1,300 feet long.
- The region is an eco-tourism magnet due to the abundance of unspoiled natural habitats with rare, indigenous wildlife.
- The islands host more than 560 bird species.
- Iguanas have inhabited the islands for the past 12 million years.
- The island reefs are relatively young – only 10-15 million years old.
- St. Maarten's airport made the top 10 list of most dangerous places to land because of its close proximity to popular Maho Beach.
